Beulah Bondi was an American actress active in film from 1931 to the 1960s. She was twice nominated for an Academy Award for best actress in a supporting role for *THE GORGEOUS HUSSY* (1936) and *OF HUMAN HEARTS* (1938).

The Beulah Bondi papers span the years 1904-1980 and encompass 4 linear feet. The collection contains clippings, press releases, correspondence, awards, recordings, photographs, playscripts, teleplays, and a scrapbook. Most of the material on Bondi's film career, entailing clippings and photographs, has been transferred to the Library's Core collection files.
