#### **Biography**

Katharine Hepburn was an American actress active from 1932 to 1994. She was nominated for twelve Academy Awards, receiving four best actress awards for *MORNING GLORY* (1933), *GUESS WHO'S COMING TO DINNER* (1967), *THE LION IN WINTER* (1968), and *ON GOLDEN POND* (1981).

#### **Collection Scope and Content Summary**

The Katharine Hepburn papers span the years 1907-2000 (bulk 1928-2000) and encompass approximately 121 linear feet. The collection consists of scripts, clippings, and production material for Hepburn's film, television, and to a lesser extent, her stage career. There is also extensive correspondence. The photograph series consists of albums and prints of motion picture production and biography photographs.
