Activities of the association have included the "Adopt-A-School Program" and the "Save the Books Campaign," in response to the fire that severely damaged the Los Angeles Public Library. The Association has also sponsored several key annual awards banquets such as the Spirit of Los Angeles Award, Corporate Award, and Community Award. These awards are given to community leaders and businesses which have voluntarily worked to promote the City of Los Angeles. The Association also sponsors forums to discuss economic and legislative issues effecting local businesses in Los Angeles, and publishes a quarterly newsletter, entitled, *Focus*.
