Includes photographs of Pullman Company, Richmond, California Shops workers, Association of Railway Supervisors Association/Western Region and a Central Pacific Railroad brass commode pot. Also contains wallet cards, a Seniority Roster, inventory cards, notices of vacancies, and bills for material, three safety awards, an October 1938 issue of PULLMAN NEWS, and a 1910 postcard. Folders 3 and 4 contain 2 Pullman job relations trainer manuals, 2 Pullman war production trainers (1943, 1944) and refresher manual + material on industrial safety.
