Biographical/Historical note

Wayne H. Maeda (1947-2013) was born in Dayton, Ohio. His parents, Masao and Ayako Maeda, were Japanese Americans formerly interned in Arizona during World War II. After Wayne's birth, his family moved to Sacramento, California where he graduated from high school in 1965. In 1967, he graduated from Sacramento City College and later, in 1969, received his B.A. in Social Science from California State University, Sacramento (CSUS). He completed his M.A. in Social Science in 1976. Maeda served as an instructor and founding member of Asian American Studies at CSUS. In 1992, he curated the Sacramento History Museum exhibit, "Continuing Traditions: Japanese Americans, Story of a People, 1869-1992". In addition, he served as a board member for the CSUS Japanese American Archival Collection Advisory Board and the National Japanese American Historical Society. In 2000, he authored the book "Changing Dreams and Treasured Memories: A Story of Japanese Americans in the Sacramento Region".
