**Abstract:** The papers of Paul B. Ryan, an American historian and retired United States Navy Captain, consist of clippings, reports, studies, other printed matter, notes, correspondence, writings, speeches, and photographs relating to Ryan's research on the 1978 Panama Canal treaty, the development of the United States Navy since World War II, the Iran hostage crisis, and Ryan himself.

**Biographical Note**

Paul B. Ryan, 1913-1987, was a captain in the United States Navy, a historian, and a research fellow at the Hoover Institution. He received a BS from the US Naval Academy in 1936, a master's degree in international relations from Stanford University, and a master's degree in history from San Jose State University. His time in the Navy included combat in World War II, three commands at sea, two tours of duty at the Pentagon, and service as US Naval Attaché for the US embassies in Havana, Cuba and Port-au-Prince, Haiti. He also served as Deputy Director of Naval History in the Department of the Navy from 1969-1972. As a Hoover scholar and historian he published multiple books, including *The Panama Canal Controversy: U.S. Diplomacy and Defense Interests* (1977), *First Line of Defense: The U.S. Navy Since 1945* (1981), and *The Iranian Rescue Mission: Why It Failed* (1985). In 1987 he received the Distinguished Service Award from the Navy League of the United States for his writings on naval history.

**Scope and Content of Collection**

The Paul B. Ryan papers consist of clippings, reports, studies, other printed matter, notes, correspondence, and writings broadly related to the Panama Canal and the 1978 Canal Treaty, the United States Navy post-World War II, the Iran hostage crisis, and Ryan himself.

Ryan organized and labeled his research materials based on subject, and from these six series were created, which were then further subdivided by topic; as a result, related materials are not necessarily located together. The **Biographical File** includes personal files, reports, and educational documents related to Ryan. **Correspondence** is organized chronologically and by topic. The **Panama Canal Controversy Research Materials File**, the **First Line of Defense Research Materials File**, and **The Iranian Rescue Mission Research Materials File** include materials gathered for use by Ryan when writing his books, as well as his notes. Finally, the **Photographs** file includes photographs and negatives largely related to the US Navy, as well as some related to the Panama Canal and the Iran hostage crisis.
