**Biography**

There is currently very little biographical information available about Warren Duff. Born May 17, 1904 in San Francisco CA, Duff participated in multiple aspects of the entertainment industry including acting, producing and writing for both film and television. Perhaps best known for his work as a writer, Duff garnered an Edgar Allen Poe Award nomination for his film *Chicago Deadline* in 1950. Warren Duff died of cancer in in Los Angeles, CA on August 5, 1973.

Collection consists of scripts related to the career of writer Warren Duff. The collection includes various versions of television and motion picture scripts. The bulk of the scripts are related to his television career and include writings for *The FBI*, *Mannix*, *The Rogues*, and others.
