Paul Radin was born Sept 15, 1913 in New York. He died Oct. 18, 2001 in Santa Barbara, CA.

The collection contains background material (including a six page typescript autobiography), as well as tapes and transcripts from 1999 interviews on Radin's role as a producer in the film industry, responsible for movies such as *Born Free*, and recollections of film stars such as Charles Chaplin (for whom he wrote the advertising campaign for *Monsieur Verdoux*), Charles Laughton, Heddy Lamar, Humphrey Bogart, and Yul Brynner.
