Lisa computer includes motherboard, CPU, videoboard, system, power supply, logic, micro systems design, two-inch and six-inch hard drives, and Lisa Lite adaptor. "Twiggy" design includes intelligent controller, test equipment, logic, analog BD, and the digital board. The remaining schematics are primarily for logic boards.
