Scope and Content Note

The Winifred V. Ramplee-Smith collection consists mainly of printed matter relating to the outbreak of the February Revolution in Petrograd and Moscow. It includes anti-monarchist propaganda booklets, revolutionary leaflets and

wall-posters. Of special interest are rare copies of contemporary newspapers, including, [Izvestiia](#), [Novoe Vremia](#), and [Vestnik Vremennago Pravitel'stva](#). Also of interest are photographs depicting leaders of the Provisional Government and scenes of the revolution.

Winifred V. Ramplee-Smith was secretary to Lord Templewood and subsequently to Sir Samuel Hoare in Petrograd from 1916-1917. She was in Moscow when the revolution broke out and began collecting printed matter related to the events she witnessed.
